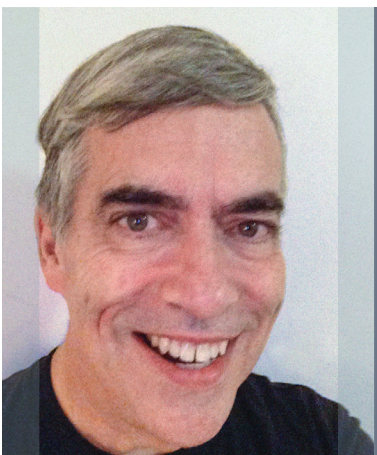

In Baltimore, he served as an English teacher and department chair at Cristo Rey Jesuit HS and was the director and English teacher at Yap Catholic HS in Micronesia.
